Diabetes UK invites applications for this Fellowship from allied health professionals, nurses and midwives who would like to pursue a PhD in diabetes research. The Fellowship is for a period of up to three years, however it may be held on a part-time basis over a longer period. The salary will be paid pro-rata and commensurate with the candidate's salary at the time of appointment and fees for the PhD will be provided at a UK Higher Education rate. Applicants may apply for up to £14,000 per annum for justifiable research costs and up to £1,500 for relevant training over the period of the award.
